Who we are:

The Parent Enhancement Program (PEP) provides supportive services to young parents in Benton County, helping them strengthen their parenting abilities, acquire life skills, form social networks, attain school and employment goals, and improve their family's well-being. Services are free of charge and offered in English and Spanish. To qualify, a parent must be under the age of 26 and reside in Benton County.

To become a volunteer or intern:

No parenting experience is required to volunteer with PEP. Call Amanda at 541/758-8292 to set up an interview. Applicants are required to obtain background checks. The following volunteer positions are available:

- Volunteer Mentors are matched with a PEP family and meet with them regularly for a period of at least one year.
- Volunteer Event Staff help set up and take down PEP events.
- Volunteer Class Leaders lead activities at PEP events. Please contact us if you have any skill or knowledge you'd like to share! Sewing and crafts experts are particularly needed.
- Volunteer Childcare Providers provide structured care for children while parents attend PEP events. Middle school and high school volunteers are welcome.
- Transportation Volunteers provide rides for families to PEP events and community appointments.
- Interns from local colleges receive academic credit while gaining valuable hands-on experience with a non-profit social service agency.
